THE FABULOUS *BARICH DE WASHOE

6-year-old pure Spanish stallion.

*BARICH de WASHOE (Zurich x *Aldebaran II) is double-Malvito . . . and Malvito, until his death, was generally considered to be the finest Arabian stallion in Europe. Bred by Luis de Ybarra, Seville, Spain, *BARICH, like his double grandsire, typifies the classic conformation excellence that has become a hallmark of the Spanish Arabian. *BARICH has, and passes along to his progeny, the extreme distinctive "Malvito head." All of his foals have the characteristic huge, wide-set eyes of the Malvito line, giving distinction and beauty to the race.

In every respect, *BARICH is a stallion of exquisite elegance and perfect conformation. He stands 15 hands, is extremely athletic but classic, and has a long flat croup and finely arched neck. He is the capstone of a carefully planned breeding program supervised by the Spanish Government.

Because the Spanish Government has instituted an embargo on the export of stallions, and because they discourage the export of mares in foal, *BARICH is, to our knowledge, the only living pure-Spanish imported stallion standing at stud in the United States. And he will probably maintain this distinction for a long time. Like diamonds, his foals are rare and valuable.

The intensified pedigree shown on the facing page makes *BARICH the perfect "out-cross" for Crabbet, Polish, and Egyptian mares. Notice that *BARICH has three crosses to Ursus through that stallion's most influential son, Gandhi. Ursus was purchased from Russia by the Spanish Government and is often characterized as the "Skowronek of Spain." The stallion, Nana Sahib, who appears twice in the pedigree, is a grandson of the great Skowronek and a son of the beautiful Crabbet mare, Jalila. Lady Wentworth was of the opinion that Jalila was Skowronek's best daughter. Illustre was the sire of the famous Spanish stallion, Congo.

*BARICH de WASHOE is not Polish. Nor is he Egyptian. He is Spanish . . . a unique product of the Iberian Peninsula. But his ancestry traces to the mainsprings of the breed that existed in England, Eastern Europe, and in the desert.
